Matthew Berry will host the party where those in attendance will celebrate both the award winners and the 1-year anniversary of New Jersey's first legal sports bet. All registered attendees of the All American Sports Betting Summit, finalists and judges are invited to attend and the event is open to others by invitation.

Nominations for the 14 award categories are now open. The key dates for the inaugural edition of the awards are:

- May 6, 2019 – Finalists announced
- June 18, 2019 – Winners announced at the All American Sports Betting Summit at Monmouth Park Racetrack
